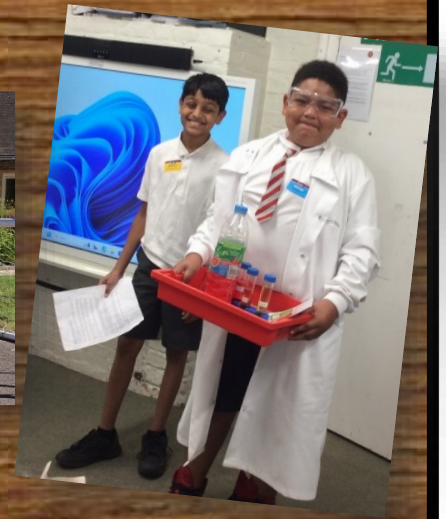

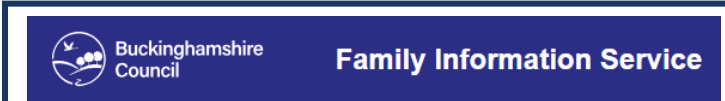
## OAK


In Lime we have been thinking about transition into our new classes and have written letters to our new teachers.
